<p>1. The aim of Junior Week is to provide a safe environment for children to have fun sailing. Some instruction will be provided but this is not a training course.</p> <p>2. We will be using a small team of RYA qualified coaches most of whom have learnt their sailing as WWSC members over the past few years. Each of these coaches has undertaken a minimum of 10 days training and assessment at their own expense.</p> <p>3. Safety cover using club patrol boats and radios will be provided using volunteer crews. We depend on parents volunteering to take on this role. Training can be provided if necessary.</p> <p>4. In line with club rules please ensure boats and children are insured: personal insurance against injury, accident or loss whilst sailing is your responsibility and WWSC accepts no responsibility for any such injury, accident, damage or loss.</p> <p>5. Parents must ensure that their children's boats are correctly rigged and sea worthy before each session. Our instructors cannot be responsible for rigging your boat.</p> <p>6. We expect a responsible adult to remain in the vicinity of the creek while children are taking part.</p> <p>7. Children should be able to swim 25 meters in light clothing and must come properly equipped to spend three or more hours on the water.</p> <p>8. From experience we know that this course works best if everyone is sailing the same boat. If at all possible please try to arrange for your child to be able to use a Topper.</p>
